


## 第3

尼希米時代的耶路撒冷城牆大約呈倒三角形,北面較短,東西兩面較長,故近似倒錐形。 按反時鐘順序:

- ❖ 北面有羊門(V1,32)、魚門(V3)、古門(V6)等三個城門,
- ❖ 西面僅有谷門(V13),
- ❖ 最南端為糞廠門(V14),
- ◆ 東面則有泉門(V15)、水門(V26)、 馬門(V28)、東門(V29)、哈米弗甲門(V31)等五個城門,本章 共記載了十個城門。

  - Ne 4:1 When Sanballat heard that we were rebuilding the wall, he became angry and was greatly incensed. He ridiculed the Jews,
  - Ne 4:3 Tobiah the Ammonite, who was at his side, said, "What they are building—even a fox climbing up on it would break down their wall of stones!"
  - Ne 4:6 So we rebuilt the wall till all of it reached half its height, for the people worked with all their heart.
  - Ne 4:7 But when Sanballat, Tobiah, the Arabs, the Ammonites and the people of Ashdod heard that the repairs to Jerusalem's walls had gone ahead and that the gaps were being closed, they were very angry.
  - Ne 4:10 Meanwhile, the people in Judah said, "The strength of the laborers is giving out, and there is so much rubble that we cannot rebuild the wall."
  - Ne 4:13 Therefore I stationed some of the people behind the lowest points of the wall at the exposed places, posting them by families, with their swords, spears and bows.
  - Ne 4:15 When our enemies heard that we were aware of their plot and that God had frustrated it, we all returned to the wall, each to our own work.
  - Ne 4:17 who were building the wall. Those who carried materials did their work with one hand and held a weapon in the other,
  - Ne 4:19 Then I said to the nobles, the officials and the rest of the people, "The work is extensive and spread out, and we are widely separated from each other along the wall.
